Background	 Please tell us why your proposed consortium came together and when you plan to be operational (100 word limit): In 2005 Blue Sky was established in the South to reduce re-offending by offering employment solely to ex-offenders. In 2009 Blue Sky expanded into the North West with operations run under franchise by Groundwork Manchester, a charity that has also delivered impressive results. To date nearly 700 ex-offenders have been employed and only 15% have re-offended – a quarter of the national average. Objective	What does your consortium aim to achieve and deliver when it is operational? What stakeholder groups will benefit from your consortium's offer (100 word limit)? By winning work from the local authorities that consortium members have positive commercial relationships with and the national private sector companies that Blue Sky already works with, BSN aims to employ 300 ex-offenders over 3 years.
