| Background | Please tell us why your proposed consortium came together and when you plan to be operational: We came together as all the partners had a shared interest in furthering work in the area of conservation and for production. Links had already been established with probation by several of the volunteer sector organisations, Community Payback, and so the consortium came together to explore ways of linking the land based work with probation activity. The partners discovered a commonality in approach and working and made the decision that the best vehicle to further this activity would be to set up a new, joint organisation. |

| Objective | What does your consortium aim to achieve and deliver when it is operational? Our consortium has a number of aims but in the short term our primary aim will be to set up a Community Interest Company that can be used a vehicle to take forward an expansion of our Green Shoots model. Green Shoots will attempt to set up a commercially viable model that provide vocational training and (self) employment opportunities for offenders within a protected workplace setting. We hope to form a sustainable working model that can then be extended to other geographical areas through a franchise model. What stakeholder groups will benefit from your consortium's offer?
